### **Talks**

The folks at Island Outfitters cannot make the January time and so will try for the April General Meeting. However, Ian Roberts, the Communications Manager for Marine Harvest Canada, will present a talk on fish farming at the February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 General Meeting.

### **NSRG**

The VFGPA has a large number of family members with many children. If you have a family membership and children in the 12 to 16 years age group who would be interested in learning the basics of shooting (initially .22 rifle – 3 position) please give me a call or email. The course would be at the NSRG range on McTavish Crossroad – just west of Dunsmuir Lodge and would be taught by Al Hargreaves – the Program Director for NSRG junior members and an accomplished coach. Depending on the response, the program may expand to include other shooting venues.

The NSRG has agreed to sell (for a token price) some of the 6" X 36" X 30+ft. laminated beams they own. The VFGPA will use these beams for a variety of purposes including enhancing the silhouette range, coring safety berms and possibly making shooting benches. There is a very generous offer.

### **National Archery in Schools Program (NASP)**

Bill Tozer is now certified to teach and qualify instructors for this program. In addition, he is available to train BCWF members who may wish to deliver the program to BCWF member clubs or other community groups such as Guides, Scouts, YM/YWCA etc. The program offers for sale a kit including bows, arrows and a back-stop curtain. ## BCWF NOTES

### **Partner Benefits**

The BCWF has partnered with Imagewear (a division of Mark's Work Wearhouse) to allow BCWF members savings of 10% (off regular retail prices) on a wide range of merchandise. All BCWF members will soon receive a Pay-As-You-Go Account Card to use at any Mark's Work Wearhouse location. Once a foundation of sales has been established in B.C. a percentage will go directly to BCWF.

### **Becoming An Outdoors Woman**

This program is designed to give women 19 years or older the opportunity to learn outdoor skills (primarily associated with hunting and fishing) in a non-competitive atmosphere. The VFGPA has approximately 330 family memberships representing that many, or more, women who may be interested in learning such skills. The course will be held on the weekend of June 11 to 13/2010 at the Zajac Ranch in Mission B.C. to the BCWF.



### Access To Crown Lands

Members of the Tahltan Nation have set up roadblocks to deny access by resident hunters to certain Crown lands. The BCWF Native Affairs Committee has concluded that it is a dead end to ask the Attorney General to enforce the right of access. The Crown will argue that it is in the interest of public safety that they do not and will not remove blockades. The BCWF is looking into pursuing a civil suit and is awaiting the opinion of legal counsel.

In another issue, the Kwadacha First Nation has threatened to blockade public access to certain areas if they do not get a Motor Vehicle Prohibition Regulation. This regulation would disallow the use of motor vehicles by resident hunters for the period August 15 to September 30 in MU 7-40 and 7-41. Resident hunters would be required to backpack for moose while the Kwadacha used motor vehicles.

He and my mother (Leola) had been separated since I was about 13 or 14 yrs of age.

I am hoping someone will remember my dad from around 1968 and also recall a lady (his possible girlfriend) whose name was "Alva" She apparently had a strong love of animals. I am told that she may have worked for the provincial government. At one time they lived around the Cobble Hill area....?

I do know that he was a frequenter of and stopped off at many pubs during his fish and game years.

I am hoping that "Alva" is still living and hopefully, reasonably close to Victoria. And, of course, of reasonably stable and sound mind.

So, if anyone can assist me in finding or locating "Alva" I would greatly appreciate it.

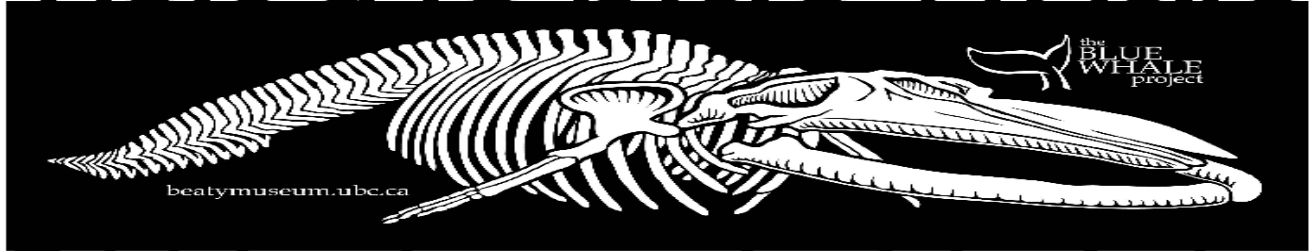

### TRAFFIC SAFETY

I received a call from club member Charlie Boas concerning traffic safety which I thought should be passed on. When heading South Bound to Victoria from Duncan it is best to make a right turn into Whitaker Road then go across the Malahat into Holker Place. This is safer than making a left off the Malahat as there is **NO SOUTH BOUND LEFT TURN LANE** into Holker Place. Also when exiting Holker Place it is best to make a right turn (North Bound) onto the Malahat then go into the left turn lane into Whitaker Rd. then you turn and enter the Malahat South Bound to Victoria.

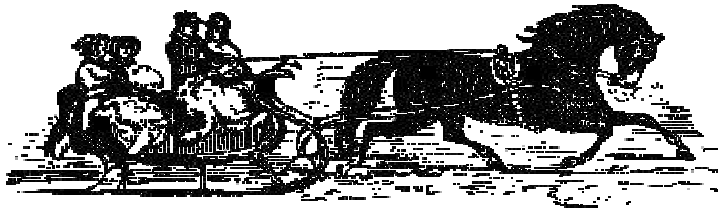

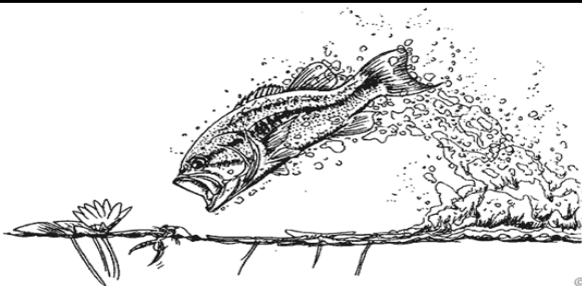
