In June the Victoria Frontier Shootists hosted a dozen girl guides at the range for an Introduction to Cowboy Action Shooting. The young ladies had a chance to shoot pistol, rifle and shotgun. At least one of the young shooters has been back for other shooting events.

On July 3rd one of our members, Joleen Wilson aka Victoria Diamond, won Lady Top Gun at the Cowboy Action Shooting BC Provincial Championships in Kamloops. Congratulations!

Pre-requisite: shot cowboy action for at least 3 times at practices or matches and have decided to continue in the sport.

The SASS Range Operation (ROI) Course is strongly recommended for all cowboy action shooters to take within the first 6 months of starting the sport. SASS membership NOT REQUIRED. The course teaches basic range operation and what is expected of each individual on the posse. Consists of 4 hours of classroom instruction, and is followed by a short test. Please print and pre-read the SASS Shooter's Handbook and RO I Course material found at the SASS web site <http://www.sassnet.com/Shooters-Handbook-001A.php> prior to the course. Current RO I 's may audit course at no cost. RO I course is a pre-requisite for SASS RO II .

WTS: WW2 German Wehrmacht G-43 Rifle. Gewehr 43 (Karabiner 43 G43, K43, Gew 43, Kar 43) is a 8x57mm caliber semi-automatic rifle developed by Third Reich Germany during World War II.

Surviving examples in working order are rare.

Mine is a Walther AC 44 I believe was possible RC issued to VOPO post war. No obvious RC markings though. (Other than electro-penciled numbers) All Waffenamt (WaA) Stamps and proof marks retain the Third Reich markings and WaA numbers. Mine has Apfelter Waffenfabrik springs and shooters kit installed, (See: <http://www.apfelter.com/>) but I will include the original parts as well. 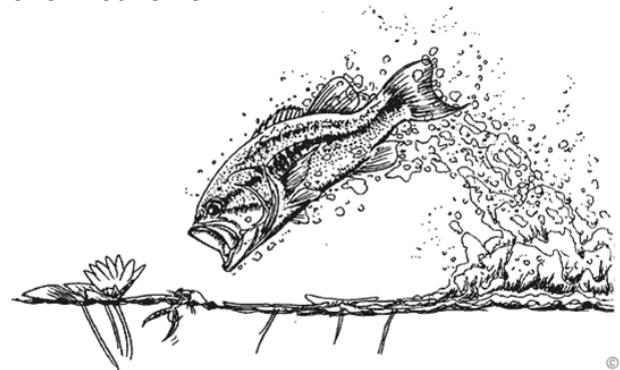

BIG GAME RECORDS BOOKS

Copies of the newly published eighth edition (2010) of the Vancouver Island Columbian Blacktail Deer Records are available at a cost of \$5 each. The issue contains a brief history of the records which were started in 1972 by Byron Mason and Charles Veasey. Byron Mason has written another excellent article on the history of hunting on Vancouver Island from 1900 to 1920. The previous seventh edition (2000) contained Byron's piece on blacktail deer populations and hunting on Vancouver Island from 1843 to 1899.

The current records list 1824 entries scoring 100 or more Boone & Crockett points. Several old hunting photographs have been reproduced for the first time in the Vancouver Island deer records booklet.

NEW 6TH EDITION BIG GAME RECORDS BOOK

A new 6th edition **BIG GAME RECORDS OF BRITISH COLUMBIA** has been published by the Wildlife Records Club of B.C. The 480 page hardcover book features a fall Grizzly painted by Prince George wildlife artist, Ken Ferris, on the front cover.

The book contains more than 9000 entries in 19 big game categories and lists over 1900 new entries received since the 2003 edition. Included are feature articles of general interest along with a wide variety of pictures and hunting stories related to the more recent entries.

The Wildlife Records Club of British Columbia was formed in Kamloops in 1969 with the objective of maintaining a perpetual record of trophy class big game taken in British Columbia. Using the Boone & Crockett scoring system, the Club has scorers throughout the province for the convenience of hunters. Since 1982, directorship of the Club has been based on Vancouver Island.

The Club is dedicated to wildlife conservation, selective hunting and fair chase. Copies of the 6th edition Records Book are available from Wayne Zaccarelli (250-382-8502) or from Island Outfitters in Victoria.

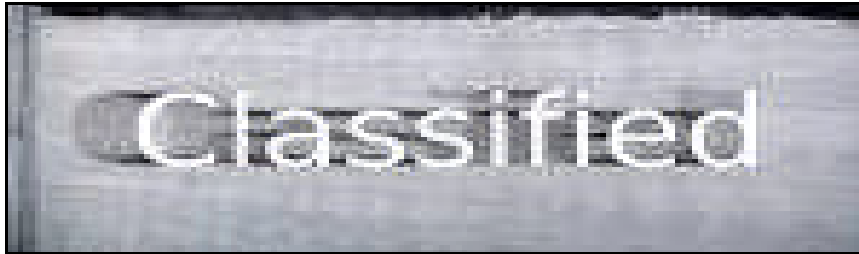

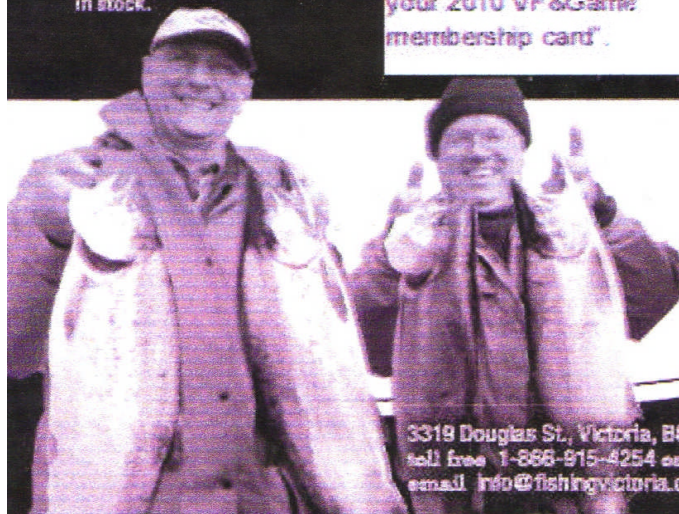
