Hello Everyone,

If you missed the news there is a Firearms Amnesty taking place in June in the Province of BC. Any unwanted firearms and ammunition can be surrendered by calling your local Police Dept. and they will arrange to pick it up. If something you want to get rid of is unregistered, illegal (but hasn't been used in a crime) you will not be charged.

The first BC Weapons Amnesty in the Province of BC was held in 1997 and I was the Coordinator for that one, seconded from the Corrections Branch for 7 months. There has been 2-3 amnesty's since then in the Province collecting ammunition, firearms, weapons anything you want to get rid of or prohibited items you are not allowed to possess in Canada (Mace, Slim Jims, brass knuckles, switch blades, metal throwing stars, silencers, etc).

If you have something with significant historical or collecting value you may want to think of donating to a museum, collector, or a firearms owner licensed for that type. Of course all transfer involve paperwork but its easy just call 1-800-731-4000 toll free. That also applies to any other legal firearm, rather then the gov't destroy them give it to another licensed firearms owner.

On a more negative note, I only like positive, I must mention a reminder: Your Club Executive/Directors are Volunteers just trying to help out! You may not want to get involved in running the club but someone has to. When dealing with fellow Club Members and Directors it is OK to disagree with them but you must be RESPECTFUL and CONTROL YOUR TEMPER WHILE DEALING WITH THE ISSUE.

BEING RUDE, CALLING NAMES, PERSONAL ATTACKS will not be tolerated, investigations will be conducted and actions taken with consequences. Trust me no one wants to go there but it is one of your Boards Responsibilities and it will be done.

TRAP SHOOTING HISTORY

OK, so how about a little bit of Trap shooting history? Did you know that in the mid 1800's they organized shotgun competitions with the competitors shooting at real live pigeons or blackbirds?

Originally the birds were "trapped" below the shooter's stove pipe top hats which were pulled off with a string to release the "birds", but this soon progressed to the use of a dedicated wooden "Trap" to release the live birds.

When the use of real birds became politically incorrect (and it also became hard to get enough pigeons for a big shoot!) they switched to round glass, hand blown "target balls" of about 2 5/8" diameter which were thrown into the air from the arm of a spring loaded "Trap".


"Doc Bogardus" was the patent holder of the glass target ball in North American and also one of the world's best shots when it came to breaking them! The problem with glass target balls though was the large amounts of broken glass that were left behind after a big shoot, so then the logical progression was made to use small, round clay balls of about 2" diameter which were invented and sold by a Mr. Chamberlain.


Then, just after the turn of the century George Ligowsky invented the "Ligowsky Clay Target", a round, flattened terra cotta clay target very similar to today's Trap and Skeet targets.

Eventually it became the most popular design of shotgun target, but the material was improved by the use of "clay" to produce the targets rather than using terra cotta.

So now you know ...



Range Update; Recent Rifle/Pistol Range Improvements.....

Your Volunteer Board of Directors has been working towards expanding each of our facilities.

You will now have noticed that our Rifle/Pistol Range has an extended 25 yard line, an extended 50 yard line, an extended 100 yard line, and also a new 250 yard line, to complement our existing 200 yard line.

We also now have a full complement of shooting tables for our members to use at the firing line, to bring the total up to 31 shooting tables.

The preparation and planning of these improvements has been ongoing for the past year. Site preparation and ground-work were preformed earlier in the year.

Range Update; Recent Rifle/Pistol Range Improvements, and

Range Rule Changes.....

With the addition of the 22 Silhouette target stands and sand backstops, we have had to add an additional rule to our Range Rules.

New Range Rule #8 for the Rifle/Pistol Range reads;

- The left side of the range is set up with four sets of metal target stands with sand berm backers held by wood backstops. This is for 22 rimfire silhouette match and practice ONLY. No centre-fire ammo is to be used.

Please Respect this rule and do not use any centre-fire ammunition when using the 22 Silhouette facilities. The wood sand backstop is to support the sand ONLY, and will not stand-up or last long as a bullet stop. Also, even if you are shooting a 22 rimfire, please DO NOT post any targets



to the wood back-stops (for the same reason..... the wood will not last long). Please use the coloured metal stands to mount targets.

Remember the Lesson from your P.A.L. course; "Always be sure of your target...AND what is behind it!"





BIG GAME COMPETITION / RECORDS BOOKS

Copies of the eighth edition (2010) of the Vancouver Island Columbian Blacktail Deer Records are available at a cost of \$5 each. The issue contains a brief history of the records which were started in 1972 by Byron Mason and Charles Veasey. Byron has written another excellent article on the history of hunting on Vancouver Island from 1900 to 1920. The previous seventh edition (2000) contained Byron's piece on Blacktail deer populations and hunting on Vancouver Island from 1843 to 1899.

The current records list 1824 entries scoring 100 or more Boone & Crockett points. Several old hunting photographs have been reproduced for the first time in the records booklet.

The most recent sixth edition (2010) of the Big Game Records of British Columbia is available for \$35 each. These are hard cover books containing records of all native big game species in B.C. Hunting stories, photographs and a listing, by species category, of entries meeting the minimum score requirements, are included.
