Hello Members, a few house keeping items:

ALL NEW MEMBERS MUST TAKE THE ORIENTATION COURSE BEFORE THEY ARE ALLOWED TO USE THE CLUBS RANGES.

EVERYONE NEEDS TO SIGN IN WHEN AT THE RANGE!!

You cannot sign in anyone (for Free) on your Memberships. (if you don't have a Membership Card you have to have a Day-Pass displayed on you)

Sweeping your brass/steel/empty hulls off the concrete and/or leaving them on the ground is **not acceptable**. Please clean up after yourself. We have a lot of range users that do not know the rules (Day-Pass Users or New Members that haven't taken the mandatory "Orientation Course") please educate anyone not cleaning up after themselves. Extra buckets have been put at each range, these are not garbage buckets they are to be used for Brass Cartridges (recycle) on the R/P and M/P Range, shotgun shells on the S/G Range. All garbage (paper, plastic, cardboard) goes into the garbage cans.

Please print your Name/Member Number when you sign in, we **NEED** to be able to read what you **Write / Print**. **YOU MUST INITIAL THE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT THAT YOU KNOW THE RULES OF THE CLUB**

If **4:45pm** is Closing Time the last shot is **4:15pm**, you have 1/2 hr. to clean up and be past the main gate before it is locked. You need to be on the other side of the main gate by **4:45pm**. Range staff have already worked their 8 hours and would like to go home and see their families.




The Victoria Women Shooters are looking for a new director

Dear Prime Minister,

As President of the BC Wildlife Federation, representing over 40,000 hunters and anglers, I am writing to say we are appalled by the senseless murder of two people and the wounding of other helpless individuals in Toronto by a deranged young man. Our heartfelt sympathies go out to the victims of the Danforth attack and to their families.

BCWF members are alarmed by the Toronto Mayor's irrational criticism of law-abiding firearms owners, whose comments were echoed by Public Safety Minister Goodale. Even though the police have yet to issue an official report about the murder weapon or how the killer obtained it, somehow these politicians believe that more restrictions on law-abiding firearms owners are needed. Unsurprisingly, Statistics Canada data do not support the claim that law-abiding gun owners are a major source of "crime guns."

We believe that calls for gun control are nothing more than a "red herring" intended to divert attention away from police failure to deal with criminals. News reports, citing "anonymous police sources," claim the killer had stolen the gun used in the unprovoked attacks from his brother. His brother, who was "known to police" as a gang member with a serious criminal record, could not have possessed any gun legally.

We are dismayed that the Toronto Mayor and your Minister would make the Toronto shooting a "gun control" issue. Instead of calling for more laws, perhaps a better approach would be to enforce the current laws. I respectfully request that the government focus on gangsters, not responsible firearm owners.

Thank you for considering my comments and my request. I would appreciate a response to this letter.

NEW 7th EDITION BIG GAME RECORDS OF B.C.

The new 7th edition of the *Big Game Records of British Columbia* is now available at a cost of \$35. The 560 page hard cover book is published by the Wildlife Records Club of B.C. "This is the official records book for exceptional big game species native to British Columbia, based on the Boone and Crockett scoring system." The book lists more than 10,000 entries in 19 big game categories with over 1400 of these being new entries since the previous edition in 2010.

The book includes feature articles, many pictures and hunting stories related to several of the recent entries. "This is a book for all who have an interest in the outstanding diversity and abundance of big game in British Columbia."

"The foundation for the Wildlife Records Club of British Columbia was originally conceived in Kamloops in 1967 with the objective of maintaining a perpetual record of trophy-class big game from British Columbia." Since 1982, operations of the Club have been based on Vancouver Island. The Club continues to qualify volunteer scorers located throughout the province.





**PAY ATTENTION LYMAN OWNERS AND FRIENDS OF SAME!!!**

Check your Lyman 50 cal. Safety Warning:

Lyman has determined that some black powder rifles and pistols could, under certain circumstances, develop separation in the breech plug, which may pose a potential safety hazard. Please do not load or use any rifles or pistols subject to this recall.

How to Identify Rifles and Pistols Subject to the Recall:

Find the serial number where the barrel meets the tang, opposite of the lock. The serial number has the letter "A" followed by a series of 6 numbers.

Action to be Taken:

If the serial number is within the range of A595960–A599026, immediately discontinue any use of this product. Please contact the Lyman Customer Service Department by emailing customerservice@lymanproducts.com or by calling 800-225-9626 Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. EST. You will be asked to provide your contact information, serial number, and either the part number or model to process the return.

Anyone outside the U.S.A. who is in possession of a black powder rifle or pistol within the recall range should contact your local distributor immediately.

BRASS PROGRAM

Just another reminder to our members to PLEASE only put fired pistol and rifle cartridge cases (brass or steel) into the plastic range brass buckets that are provided on the firing line. Please use the provided garbage cans on our ranges to dispose of your garbage and ONLY put your fired rifle and pistol cartridge cases in the buckets provided for range brass. If you could please do that it would definitely help to make our job a lot easier and a lot less disgusting. It is a nasty, time consuming job to separate and sort all of the garbage out of the brass buckets first. (Come on people, the garbage can is located only mere FEET away from the brass buckets!)

The volume of saleable, reloadable brass is down noticeably over the past year or so and I'd just like to remind our members once more that while we pretty much consider any brass that is still lying on the ground or on the concrete to be "fair game" if you'd like to pick it up for personal use, fired brass which has been placed into the club's plastic range buckets are then considered to be the property of the club. It appears that there are shooters who are "raiding" the range buckets and taking the club's fired brass. All of the funds that are generated from brass sales, including scrap brass, goes directly to the club and helps to pay for repairs, upkeep, and improvements on the range property. (And the recent purchase of the club's new rental chronograph.) If you take brass from the range buckets you are essentially denying revenue to the club which is used to your benefit. We'd ask that you please respect our "once the brass is in the bucket it stays in the bucket" policy for the benefit of all of our members.

Just a reminder too that the brass we sell through the club's brass recover program is sold "as received" in the range buckets and you will need to tumble it to clean it before you reload it. Some of it is once fired from factory ammunition, and some of it may have been reloaded several times. We have absolutely no control over that and it up to you to clean it and then inspect it carefully before you reload it. You get it just as we receive it and we do NOT guarantee it to be only once fired.



**SAFETY REMINDERS--PLEASE READ****FIREARMS--CASES--BENCHES**

- * Firearms are to be cased and uncased ONLY during Live Periods and preferably only at the Firing line (forward wooden benches) Actions open, Magazines removed (empty cases can be returned to rear gear tables)
- * Firearms are to be Loaded and Unloaded ONLY on the Firing Line (forward wooden shooting Benches)
- * Muzzles are always to be pointed down range or upwards.
(magazine may be filled or emptied at the rear gear benches and tables).

“CEASE FIRE” ROUTINE/PROCEDURES:

- * Remove ammunition from the Chamber. Remove magazines from the action
- * Leave actions visibly open-(a chamber flag helps visibility!)
Then- **Your Choice:**
- * Leave firearm(muzzle pointed down range, magazine removed, action open) on FIRING LINE bench.

Or

- * Carry firearm muzzle up and place in rear wall rack- magazine removed action open.
- * Remember to take needed targets, tape, stapler, beverage, etc. with you when leaving the shooting bench area for the Cease Fire Period. (An RSO can retrieve forgotten items.)
- * During a Cease Fire DO NOT go within 3 metres of the firearms on the bench or handle firearms on the racks(Remember your P.A.L. Course). Do not touch anything on your shooting table. (An RSO can retrieve forgotten items).
- * During a Cease Fire the divided concrete slab area around the shooting benches is to be used to walk through only on the way to your target and back. Please remain off the shooting table area concrete during cease fire periods.

Safety Tip

Each Range has a Perimeter Flag. If the Red Flag is in the UP position that is a indicator that the range is active. Even if their is a cease fire shooting can start at anytime.

It is a good idea to put your Hearing Protection on at the Perimeter Flag before you get to the active range. (Range Rules require that hearing and eye protection be worn on the Ranges.)

The Federal Licensing Course suggest you wear both in ear and outside ear protection, another option is the "Electronics Earmuffs" Good Christmas List need item.

Once your hearing is damage it cannot be fixed and it does not repair itself.

VICTORIA FISH & GAME ANNUAL BIG GAME COMPETITION

Hunters are reminded that Blacktail deer taken in MU 1-1 through 1-13 by Victoria Fish & Game members are eligible for the five trophies available each year. Deer must be field dressed which means that the heart, liver and kidneys (edible portions) are the only internal organs which can be included when the animal is weighed. Deer must be weighed on Club scales by the caretaker or his designate.

The official weigher reserves the right to refuse weighing any deer which arrives in an unpresentable condition. Lungs must be removed and body cavity wiped dry with a rag or paper towels. Deer 160 pounds and over taken with a rifle and 140 pounds and over taken by bow and arrow must be witnessed by an executive member at time of weighing. Please contact the Club caretaker/manager or Wayne Zaccarelli to make arrangements. Hunters are reminded that access to club facilities is restricted to daylight hours with the gate locked progressively earlier through the hunting season. Please ensure that you confirm the time gates are locked and show up at least a half hour earlier.

Trophies available include:

- McIlwaine Van & Storage (est. 1955) largest deer / rifle
- Victoria Fish & Game (est. 1966) largest scoring antlers
- Robinson's Sporting Goods (est. 1970) largest deer / bow & arrow
- Bob Hollingworth Memorial (est. 1983) largest buck deer / junior member
- Malahat Marauders (est. 1990) largest deer / muzzle loader

Gold, silver and bronze buttons are awarded in both rifle and bow & arrow

classes for deer in the following weight categories:

Gold	180 lb +	160 lb +
Silver	160 - 179 ½ lb	140 - 159 ½ lb
Bronze	140 - 159 ½ lb	120 - 139 ½ lb

In addition, the Victoria Fish & Game Bear trophy is awarded annually for the largest Black bear taken by a Club member. Boone & Crockett Club scoring is used to determine the largest entry. Boundaries are again MU 1-1 through 1-13.

FISHING:

- Premier Horgan announced formation of a *Wild Salmon Advisory Council* under the Ministry of Agriculture. The Council is comprised of 14 members representing environmentalists, First Nations, politicians, commercial and recreational fishermen. Local anglers are well represented with Ian Bruce, Martin Paish, Mike Hicks and Ward Bond appointed.
- Jonathon Wilkinson, MP North Vancouver, was appointed the new Minister of Fisheries and Oceans on July 18. He replaces Dominic Leblanc.
- As a result of additional sportfishing restrictions, closures and the negative publicity this summer, the August 11-12 Juan de Fuca Fishing Derby was cancelled July 20 due to low ticket sales. The South Vancouver Island Anglers' Coalition organizes the derby and proceeds are used to support the Sooke Chinook Restoration Initiative netpen project.
- A protest fishery took place July 29 in the closed area between Otter Point and Sheringham Point. Anglers trolled without hooks to raise attention to the unfair closures they are faced with this summer. DFO unfairly targeted recreational anglers while failing to address other user groups and options which should have been incorporated into the Southern Resident Killer Whale (SRKW) Recovery Plan. Whale watchers (vessel noise) closed areas, seal & sea lion control and increased salmon enhancement were not adopted. On top of that, numerous First Nations only commercial Chinook fisheries have been instituted over the last couple months.
- A new society has been formed to lobby the new Fisheries & Oceans Minister to allow a seal and sea lion harvest. The Pacific Balance Pinnipeds Society is comprised of Tsawwassen First Nations, commercial and sport fishermen.
- The sportfishery was opened to the retention of sockeye salmon effective August 01 with a daily limit of four. This is the dominant cycle year for sockeye heading to the Fraser River. Harvestable surpluses exist with the many millions returning through Juan de Fuca and Georgia Straits.

CUTTHROAT INITIATIVE

The World Fisheries Trust, in cooperation with the Victoria Golden Rods & Reels, has completed an application to the Freshwater Fisheries Society of B.C. for funding to conduct a project addressing coastal cutthroat trout in Colquitz and Craigflower Creeks and the adjacent marine estuarine environment of Portage Inlet, Gorge Waterway and Victoria Harbour. The *Native Trout Stewardship Initiative* is a matching funds grant designed to "...support stewardship groups in their efforts to protect and restore wild freshwater fish, the habitats they live in and the fisheries they provide."

The Victoria Fish & Game has donated \$2000 toward the project. The Esquimalt Anglers' have contributed \$1000 as has the Amalgamated Conservation Society. Other societies have contributed as well.

WILDLIFE RECORDS CLUB OF B.C.

The Wildlife Records Club of B.C. will provide up to \$2500 annually to individuals or organizations for projects which further the conservation goals and objectives of the Club and which benefit B.C.'s big game populations. Suitable uses could include habitat manipulation or enhancement, collection and analysis of information, or students and organizations requiring funds to achieve their goals. Applicants should submit a maximum three page funding proposal by February 15. The WRCBC will review the applications and make funding decisions by March 31 annually. NEW VANCOUVER ISLAND DEER BOOK


Copies of the ninth edition (2016) of the Vancouver Island Columbian Blacktail Deer Records are available at a cost of \$10 each. The publication contains an excellent article written by Byron Mason on fifty years with the deer in the Nimpkish Valley. Byron relates the impact of wolf and cougar predation on deer population abundance and hence, hunting success. He also includes 45 years of deer count data from 1970 through 2015.

There is also an article on early cougar hunting where the provincial government paid a bounty of varying amounts on cougars taken between 1870 and 1958. The new edition contains numerous colour photographs of harvested deer as well as record heads and antlers.

Copies of the previous eighth edition (2010) are still available at a cost of \$5.00. The current records list over 2160 entries scoring 100 or more Boone & Crockett points.

Of particular note is the re-scoring of the Norm Hammond buck from 1942. These antlers were the number two head in the previous eighth edition (2010) scoring 139 7/8.

Following a request from the current owner, it was panel scored in March 2015 and is now ranked as the number one Vancouver Island deer with a score of 143 5/8.


