DANGER TO LEGAL FIREARMS OWNERSHIP

Bill C-71 has passed through the House of Commons and is now in the Senate to be debated. Bill C-71 if passed by the Senate will come into force likely in December 2018. The Liberal Government will begin reclassifying all firearms in early 2019 and begin confiscations. If the Liberals are re-elected in the fall of 2019 major confiscations of legally owned firearms from licensed owners will escalate! They will begin with semi automatic hunting rifles then move on to semi automatic handguns. The Liberals will re-classify these types of firearms then grandfather as a gesture. But will confiscate when they deem it timely! By the end of their second term there will no longer be any shooting sports in Canada. After this they will begin to highly restrict regular hunting rifles and shotguns!

This initiative will be supported by a massive public relations campaign and fictitious data rigged by the Government plus suppression of information regarding terrorist and criminal use of firearms just as the prelude to C-71 has been promoted.

The Liberals, NDP, Bloc, and Greens firmly believe the people of Canada should have no property rights and each would form regimes that are totalitarian.

Andrew Scheer of the Conservative Party of Canada has stated "if the Conservatives form a Government in the fall of 2019 Bill C-71 will be repealed".

The immediate remedies are: write all the Senators regarding the negative effects of Bill C-71 on legal, licensed firearms owners. Join any and all firearms activist associations and support the Conservative Party of Canada. 2.2million PAL holders are 12.5 percent of the eligible voters in Canada. 2.2million voters supporting the Conservatives plus the 5.5million who voted for them in 2015 Canada will have a Conservative Government in the fall of 2019.

This will be the last battle of legitimate, licensed firearms owners. If they loose, only criminals will have guns.

We have a lot of range users that do not know the rules (Day-Pass Users or New Members that haven't taken the mandatory "Orientation Course") please educate anyone not cleaning up after themselves. Extra buck-ets have been put at each range, these are not garbage buckets they are to be used for Brass Cartridges (recycle) on the R/P and M/P Range, shotgun shells on the S/G Range. All garbage (paper, plastic, cardboard) goes into the garbage cans.

Please print your Name/Member Number when you sign in, we **NEED** to be able to read what you **Write / Print**. YOU MUST INITIAL THE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT THAT YOU KNOW THE RULES OF THE CLUB

If **4:45pm** is Closing Time the last shot is **4:15pm**, you have 1/2 hr. to clean up and be past the main gate before it is locked. You need to be on the other side of the main gate by **4:45pm**. Range staff have already worked their 8 hours and would like to go home and see their families.

We are doing the Holster Course and Handgun Essentials Course once a Month (usually on Sun.) but some







SHEARING SHEEP

As it stands today, we as firearm owners are in probably the most precarious and serious situation than we have been in the last thirty years. The perfect storm of shootings in our cities with two high profile shootings in particular, one in Toronto and the other in Fredericton. There are calls from Toronto and Montreal city counsels for a complete nation wide ban on handguns and "assault rifles" a big push is on from the media and anti gun groups, as well we have Bill C-71 headed for third reading mid September, with royal accent once it clears the senate, then it will be law of the land.

Our numbers on paper are 2.2 million firearm owners in Canada that is 28% percent of all the households in the country have firearms in them. The number is probably higher than that if you take into account all those who opted out of the system and are not included in those figures. Gary Mauser concluded a few years back that actual number was 40% of the households in the country. With the amount of people that own firearms, you would think that our political influence would be much greater than it is currently. Not the case, why, because we as a group have not stood up in a significant way, only one percent of gun owners are organized in Canada and this needs to change or we will lose what is left of our right to own and use firearms.

For the last forty years we have gone through a series of gun control laws, the most recent were C-17 and C-68. The most devastating one, C-68 from the mid 1990's gave us the much despised and highly controversial firearms act which we still live under today. It basically prohibited all firearms in Canada and gave an exemption in the form of a license to own, possess and purchase. What is happening and what has happened over the course of time is a slow and methodical firearm elimination plan, remember they can't do it all at once it's a step at a time approach. Action by action, barrel length by barrel length, type by type, regulation upon regulation until it is all gone. Eating an elephant one bite at a time, we have lost an incredible amount over the last four decades.

Currently in addition to C-71 the federal Liberal government is seriously considering a national handgun ban and possibly semi autos are also under consideration, we as a group need to counter this in a big way. Sign the petitions, email and write the politicians that are in charge, namely Ralph Goodale, Justin Trudeau, Bill Blair and tell them you are no longer willing to be scapegoats for criminal acts involving firearms and that they need to focus on the criminal aspect and leave the law abiding citizens of Canada alone. Counter the misinformation and bias in the media, set them straight with accurate facts.

Hand written letters are best, Ottawa considers every hand written letter to be representative of five hundred voters. Bury their desks with them and include a copy to your MP. All we have is our collective, we do not have constitutional protection like our neighbors to the south have, only our numbers. Join organizations such as the Canadian Shooting Sports Assoc. Canadian Coalition for Firearm Rights, National Firearm Assoc. check out their websites and get involved. Apathy is our demise, it's all up to us, this will never go away.

The finished Gavel will be presented at our 100 year celebration 17 June 2019



Timberwest Access Program

Our working relationship with Timberwest for hunting and fishing access continues to develop as the years roll by, and we are attracting new membership as a result. Installation of our equipment to bring the Kapoor gate online and the use of ATVs for hunting are in active discussions pending clearance by Timberwest legal counsel. We continue to support the BCWF by including BCWF direct members, and hope that by learning about our club through the access program they will join the family! Our strength is in numbers.

Recent communication with Timberwest indicates that the trust we have developed with our program has opened the door for the Cowichan Valley ATV club to make an application, and with each gate north that we can equip, we expand not only our hunting and fishing range, but through my work with the Outdoor Recreation Council, we open a door for every other club with an interest in the land.

Although only indirectly related to Timberwest as adjoining properties, I found a new gate installed over the summer on East Main that cuts off access to the Jordan River reservoirs, and have initiated an inquiry with the Ministry. It appears to be a BC Hydro gate, which is potentially a good thing for us, as Hydro has skin in the game with the development of our gate access control unit. Prior to the gate going in, I previously contacted Mike Hicks, the FLNRO staff in Alberni, and arranged a meeting between the BCWF exec. and John Horgan's constituency office staff with concerns that the road may be gated, which was apparently a waste of time and bandwidth as we were not consulted about the installation of the gate. It would have cost the exact same amount, and be a lot more robust to have installed it with our equipment. Mike Hicks has campaign signs all over the place, so now would be a good time to call him and ask why we should vote for him. 250-216-5802

The rampant illegal, and dangerously irresponsible use of firearms out there as a result of uncontrolled access is of direct concern to our club, given the current political and social assault on the legitimacy of firearm ownership. We want that road gated, so long as we have keys. The alternative is that it will be permanently deactivated, so for those pedantically "open-road" advocates with loud and poorly thought out opinions, choose your poison carefully. Open roads are the leading cause of closed roads.

Check your Lyman 50 cal. Safety Warning:

Lyman has determined that some black powder rifles and pistols could, under certain circumstances, develop separation in the breech plug, which may pose a potential safety hazard. Please do not load or use any rifles or pistols subject to this recall.

How to Identify Rifles and Pistols Subject to the Recall:

Find the serial number where the barrel meets the tang, opposite of the lock. The serial number has the letter "A" followed by a series of 6 numbers.

Action to be Taken:

If the serial number is within the range of A595960–A599026, immediately discontinue any use of this product. Please contact the Lyman Customer Service Department by emailing<u>customerservice@lymanproducts.com</u> or by calling <u>800-225-9626</u> Monday through Friday,9 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. EST. You will be asked to provide your contact information, serial number, and either the part number or model to process the return.

Anyone outside the U.S.A. who is in possession of a black powder rifle or pistol within the recall range should contact your local distributor immediately.

BRASS PROGRAM

Just another reminder to our members to PLEASE only put fired pistol and rifle cartridge cases (brass or steel) into the plastic range brass buckets that are provided on the firing line. Please use the provided garbage cans on our ranges to dispose of your garbage and ONLY put your fired rifle and pistol cartridge cases in the buckets provided for range brass. If you could please do that it would definitely help to make our job a lot easier and a lot less disgusting. It is a nasty, time consuming job to separate and sort all of the garbage out of the brass buckets first. (Come on people, the garbage can is located only mere FEET away from the brass buckets!)

The volume of saleable, reloadable brass is down noticeably over the past year or so and I'd just like to remind our members once more that while we pretty much consider any brass that is still lying on the ground or on the concrete to be "fair game" if you'd like to pick it up for personal use, fired brass which has been placed into the club's plastic range buckets are then considered to be the property of the club. It appears that there are shooters who are "raiding" the range buckets and taking the club's fired brass. All of the funds that are generated from brass sales, including scrap brass, goes directly to the club and helps to pay for repairs, upkeep, and improvements on the range property. (And the recent purchase of the club's new rental chronograph.) If you take brass from the range buckets you are essentially denying revenue to the club which is used to your benefit. We'd ask that you please respect our "once the brass is in the bucket it stays in

the bucket" policy for the benefit of all of our members.

Just a reminder too that the brass we sell through the club's brass recover program is sold "as received" in the range buckets and you will need to tumble it to clean it before your reload it. Some of it is once fired from factory ammunition, and some of it may have been reloaded several times. We have absolutely no control over that and it up to you to clean it and then inspect it carefully before you reload it. You get it just as we receive it and we do NOT guarantee it to be only once fired.

"Many thanks again to the club members who have been donating their surplus, reloadable brass to our club's brass recovery program lately, and also my very sincere thanks again to club members Art Archer and John Pitchford who have been helping with brass pickup and sorting lately. It is VERY much appreciated."



The club recently bought a basic Model F-1 Chrony which will be available for rental to our paid, card carrying club members. (We will not be renting the club chronograph to day pass users.) We will be charging a nominal fee of only \$10 for the use of the club's chronograph, which will be available to be signed out from the Caretaker's office. We will have a simple form to record the renting member's information and it will be the responsibility of the renter to return the chronograph to the office before they leave the range property. Since we suspect this will be a very popular club program I would suggest that you contact the office in advance to book your rental of the club Chrony by date, to ensure that someone else hasn't arranged to rent it on the same day. The Chrony mounts to a standard camera tripod and for the moment until the club purchases a tripod to keep at the office for use with the Chrony you will need to bring your own tripod.



SAFETY REMINDERS--PLEASE READ

FIREARMS--CASES--BENCHES

* Firearms are to be <u>cased and uncased</u> <u>ONLY</u> during Live Periods and <u>preferably</u> only at the Firing line (forward wooden benches) Actions open, Magazines removed (empty cases can be returned to rear gear tables)

* Firearms are to be Loaded and Unloaded ONLY on the Firing Line (forward wooden shooting Benches)

* Muzzles are <u>always</u> to be pointed down range or upwards.

(magazine may be filled or emptied at the rear gear benches and tables).

"CEASE FIRE" ROUTINE/PROCEDURES:

- * Remove ammunition from the Chamber. Remove magazines from the action
- * Leave actions visibly open-(a chamber flag helps visibility!)
- Then- Your Choice:
- * Leave firearm(muzzle pointed down range, magazine removed, action open) on FIRING LINE bench.

Or

* Carry firearm muzzle up and place in rear wall rack- magazine removed action open.

* Remember to take needed targets, tape, stapler, beverage, etc. with you when leaving the shooting bench area for the <u>Cease Fire Period</u>. (An RSO can retrieve forgotten items.)

* During a Cease Fire <u>DO NOT</u> go within 3 metres of the firearms on the bench or handle firearms on the racks(Remember your P.A.L. Course). Do not touch anything on your shooting table. (An RSO can retrieve forgotten items).

* During a Cease Fire the divided concrete slab area around the shooting benches is to be used to **walk through only** on the way to your target and back. Please remain off the shooting table area concrete during cease fire periods.

Safety Tip

Each Range has a Perimeter Flag. If the Red Flag is in the UP position that is a indicator that the range is active. Even if their is a cease fire shooting can start at anytime.

It is a good idea to put your Hearing Protection on at the Perimeter Flag before you get to the active range. (Range Rules require that hearing and eye protection be worn on the Ranges.)

The Federal Licensing Course suggest you wear both in ear and outside ear protection, another option is the "Electronics Earmuffs" Good Christmas List need item.

Once your hearing is damage it cannot be fixed and it does not repair itself.

VICTORIA FISH & GAME ANNUAL BIG GAME COMPETITION

Hunters are reminded that Blacktail deer taken in MU 1-1 through 1-13 by Victoria Fish & Game members are eligible for the five trophies available each year. Deer must be field dressed which means that the heart, liver and kidneys (edible portions) are the only internal organs which can be included when the animal is weighed. Deer must be weighed on Club scales by the caretaker or his designate.

The official weigher reserves the right to refuse weighing any deer which arrives in an unpresentable condition. Lungs must be removed and body cavity wiped dry with a rag or paper towels. Deer 160 pounds and over taken with a rifle and 140 pounds and over taken by bow and arrow must be witnessed by an executive member at time of weighing. Please contact the Club caretaker/manager or Wayne Zaccarelli to make arrangements. Hunters are reminded that access to club facilities is restricted to daylight hours with the gate locked progressively earlier through the hunting season. Please ensure that you confirm the time gates are locked and show up at least a half hour earlier.

Gold, silver and bronze buttons are awarded in both rifle and bow & arrow

classes for deer in the following weight categories:

Bronze	140 - 159 ½ lb	120 - 139 ½ lb

In addition, the Victoria Fish & Game Bear trophy is awarded annually for the largest Black bear taken by a Club member. Boone & Crockett Club scoring is used to determine the largest entry. Boundaries are again MU 1-1 through 1-13.

- DFO has closed the lower portion of the Fraser River to recreational salmon fishing to protect Interior Fraser Steelhead stocks of concern (ie. Thompson, Chilcotin). The non-tidal portion from Mission to the Alexandra Bridge is closed from September 29 to October 25. The tidal portion from Mission to the Fraser mouth is closed from September 28 to October 24. This presumably is to prevent incidental interception of steelhead by anglers fishing salmon. However, recreational anglers are not the reason the steelhead are in serious trouble. Steelhead populations have been decimated by incidental catch during commercial net fisheries - mainly gill net chum fisheries. They have also been heavily impacted by hundreds of gill nets within the Fraser River. Once again, the finger is being pointed at the wrong user group.


- The Sooke Salmon Enhancement Society (operating as the Jack Brooks Hatchery) and the Juan de Fuca Salmon Restoration Society (operating as the Charters River Salmon Interpretation Centre) have joined forces to construct a new salmon hatchery on the Charters River property. The Jack Brooks Hatchery had limited production due to a minimal summer water flow approaching 250 gallons per minute. The Capital Regional District (CRD Water) has guaranteed the new facility a minimum flow of 1000 gallons per minute. This will enable increased production of especially Chinook salmon. It is hoped to have the new facility ready for the fall 2019 brood stock. It will further augment the net pen release of currently 500,000 Nitinat stock Chinook in Sooke Harbour - a project of the South Vancouver Island Anglers' Coalition (SVIAC).

NEW VANCOUVER ISLAND DEER BOOK

Copies of the ninth edition (2016) of the Vancouver Island Columbian Blacktail Deer Records are available at a cost of \$10 each. The publication contains an excellent article written by Byron Mason on fifty years with the deer in the Nimpkish Valley. Byron relates the impact of wolf and cougar predation on deer population abundance and hence, hunting success. He also includes 45 years of deer count data from 1970 through 2015.

There is also an article on early cougar hunting where the provincial government paid a bounty of varying amounts on cougars taken between 1870 and 1958. The new edition contains numerous colour photographs of harvested deer as well as record heads and antlers.



Copies of the previous eighth edition (2010) are still available at a cost of \$5.00.

The current records list over 2160 entries scoring 100 or more Boone & Crockett points.

Of particular note is the re-scoring of the Norm Hammond buck from 1942. These antlers were the number two head in the previous eighth edition (2010) scoring 139 7/8.

Following a request from the current owner, it was panel scored in March 2015 and is now ranked as the number one Vancouver Island deer with a score of 143 5/8.

NEW 7th EDITION BIG GAME RECORDS OF B.C.

The new 7th edition of the *Big Game Records of British Columbia* is now available at a cost of \$35. The 560 page hard cover book is published by the Wildlife Records Club of B.C. "This is the official records book for exceptional big game species native to British Columbia, based on the Boone and Crockett scoring system." The book lists more than 10,000 entries in 19 big game categories with over 1400 of these being new entries since the previous edition in 2010.

The book includes feature articles, many pictures and hunting stories related to several of the recent entries. "This is a book for all who have an interest in the outstanding diversity and abundance of big game in British Columbia."

"The foundation for the Wildlife Records Club of British Columbia was originally conceived in Kamloops in 1967 with the objective of maintaining a perpetual record of trophy-class big game from British Columbia." Since 1982, operations of the Club have been based on Vancouver Island. The Club continues to qualify volunteer scorers located throughout the province.




