## Shooting Categories

### MODERN CATEGORY

Modern Category is an open main match category, carries no age or gender restrictions and carries the following parameters:

- Modern and Traditional style pistols are allowed
- May be shot in any shooting style
- May use any SASS legal main match shotgun and any legal main match rifle, .38 caliber or greater
- May use any SASS legal ammunition

## **TRADITIONAL CATEGORY**

Traditional Category is an open main match category, carries no age or gender restrictions and carries the following parameters:

- Only traditional style pistols are allowed
- Must be shot one handed unsupported (duelist style)
- Support hand may be used for loading, racking the slide, and in case of malfunctions
- May use any SASS legal main match shotgun and any legal main match rifle, .38 caliber or greater
- May use any SASS legal ammunition

## **OPEN CATEGORY**

To accommodate those shooters who wish to compete in Wild Bunch but lack the required firearms for either Traditional or Modern Category, we offer an "Open Category" for both men and women.

Pistol's allowed in Open Category:

- Any semi-automatic pistol
- 9mm or larger using lead bullets only
- Any barrel length
- Any standard iron front and rear sights, or fiber optic, no red dot, laser, or other high tech sights
- Magazines need minimum 4 and must accommodate at least 7 rounds each
- Magazine pouches can be used and worn on gun belt or magazines can be staged at shooting locations as needed
- Any holster must be worn at waist on strong side or pistol can be staged at first pistol shooting location
- May shoot using one or two hand method

Rifle allowed in Open Category:

- Any pistol caliber SASS legal lever action rifle using lead bullets only
- Any caliber smaller than 40 will not be allowed to shoot rifle last on stages designated as "Shooter's Choice"
- No .22 caliber

Shotgun allowed in Open Category:

- 20, 16, or 12 gauge pump shotgun is acceptable.
- Must have traditional style shotgun stock and fore grip wooden or synthetic, no pistol grip, no tactical defense style grips.
- Iron type front and rear sight, or fiber optic
- No red dot, laser or other high tech sights
- Must be shoulder fired
